These were the discussions:

- Cemetery: It is officially the City's; deed still needs to be transferred.
- Grants: 1. The Grant Committee met, approved \$2000 for flags and poles for city.
2. Grant for flowers for garden on Harrison Ave, close to public lot was approved. This money will be put into the cemetery budget from now on since this area use to be a cemetery. 3. Grant for "Good Tickets for Kids" was not approved. Committee felt that the idea was good (giving good tickets to kids in Cheviot, when they were caught doing something good, ice cream cone gift certificate etc) but wanted the Police to be more involved in the program. Felt if they wanted the program they would work with us to collect gift certificates, therefore meeting community business owners and workers. It was mentioned the business community really misses the bike cops.
- Liquor Insurance: Came in at \$1600, for WSSF, Good Job!!!
- WSSF: General discussions about what we still need people to do, volunteers signed up. Also discussed the Kidz Zone because it is new.
